We are excited to share with you that Angelwood has been awarded a Community Development Block Grant through the City of Jacksonville. This is a matching grant that will enable us to make some renovations and major repairs to the homes to make them more easily accessible, energy efficient, and generally safer for the people living in them. Our group homes are located in residential neighborhoods, where we provide 24-hour care in a home setting. Each person receives personal support from trained staff who are available to assist with personal goals and new life skills.

Like any home, over time there are things that need to be replaced, repaired, and updated beyond the normal maintenance and upkeep. While each house has different things that it needs, some of the changes include: replacement of 3 HVAC systems, replacement of old windows, removal and replacement of a leaking porch roof, repairing a driveway, making 2 bathrooms accessible, and putting a needed addition onto one of the homes.

Angelwood, Inc. has been dedicated to caring for people with developmental disabilities and their families in Northeast Florida since 1993. What began as one group home for 3 children has grown to 5 group homes and along with our non-residential programs, Angelwood provides services to over 200 children and adults and their families.
